DAMAGE REPAIR (FIRE, WATER, IMPACT, Etc.)

This document is intended to assist in procedures for the restoration of a structure damaged by fire, water, impacts or other disasters outside the owners control, with the intent of returning the structure to predamage condition.

INITIAL PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

An initial permit will be issued for assessment only. This permit can be used to clean out debris and to have a design professional analyze the damage for potential plan submittal. This permit is a flat fee of \$50.

<u>During the initial assessment phase, no MEP attachments are allowed. No repair work is</u> <u>allowed. It is for assessment of the damage only.</u>

UPGRADE PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

NO PERMITTABLE REPAIRS REQUIRED:

If it is determined there is no permittable work, an inspection can be requested for completion or we will accept a letter from a design professional confirming their findings. This letter can be emailed to matthewm@pprbd.org for review and completion of permit.

PERMITTABLE REPAIRS REQUIRED:

If it is determined that repair work is required, plans must be submitted to PPRBD and reviewed. Once that has taken place, the assessment permit can be upgraded to a remodel permit and additional fees will be assessed, based on the valuation of the remodel. At this point, the subs may attach.
